| Provide link or text which describes student degree transfer policy (from 2-year institutions to this university) Average # of EC courses offered per Term in | Carlow University participates in the Pennsylvania Transfer and Articulation Center (PA TRAC) agreement program. This agreement allows students to easily check which courses will transfer between participating colleges and universities. Students who complete an Associate degree in Early Education and Child Development at a designated/participating community college can transfer a minimum of 60 guaranteed credits to Carlow University. The Early Childhood program has created a program guide specifically for these PA TRAC students indicating the 60 additional credits they need to successfully graduate. Transfer students are given credit for all of the general education requirements (called the Carlow Compass) except for a junior anchor and service learning course. However, both of these courses are embedded into the early childhood coursework in junior and senior years. |
