Steps to Enroll in College

Gather Transcripts and Documents:
 Collect high school transcripts, GED scores, or prior college credits for submission.
Apply for Admission: Complete the college application (most have application fees).
Attend Orientation: Learn about campus resources, academic advising and student support services.
Meet with an Academic Advisor:
 Schedule placement testing and a transcript review (if you are transferring credits) and select courses.
Register for Courses: Confirm financial aid BEFORE registering to avoid being billed for tuition.
